Possible Cause	Correction
1. Oil too heavy	Change to proper viscosity
2. Oil filter plugged	2. Clean filter
3. Suction line plugged or too small	3. Clean line and check size of line
1. Oil supply low	5. Fill reservoir
2. Contaminated oil	6. Drain reservoir and refill with clean
3. Setting of relief valve too high or	oil
too low	7. Set to correct pressure
4. Oil in system too light	Drain reservoir and refill with proper viscosity oil
1. Worn shaft seal	4. Replace shaft seal
2. Worn shaft in seal area	5. Replace drive assembly
3. Debris in shaft seal suction side drain holes	6. Disassemble pump and inspect

2. Air Leaking into suction line	5. Tighten fittings
3. Wrong kind of oil	Drain and fill reservoir with non-foaming oil
