High Solids Acrythane (HSA) proved the most versatile and resilient coating. This product was created initially to meet the military requirements for a CARC (Chemical Agent Resistant Coating) specification and has proven very successful on NZ Army Armoured Troop Carriers.

Initially introduced to STEELBRO to reduce consumable wastage, the Graco Electrostatic spray system installed for application of primer and paint has brought even more benefits to STEELBRO's customers.
